Pre-requisites: Before the workshop, please do the following...

Requirement #3(b)2 - Record the trips taken, mileage, and fuel consumption of a family car for seven days, and calculate how many miles per gallon the car gets. Determine whether any trips could have been combined ("chained") rather than taken out and back. Using the idea of trip chaining, determine how many miles and gallons of gas could have been saved in those seven days.

Requirement #3(e)1 - Research and write a report about an endangered species in NY. The report should be a minimum of one page in length.

on the environment. Spend a night in your shelter. We will learn how to make a natural shelter at the workshop but will not sleep in it.
